



POSTER CONTEST

The Herkimer County Prevention Council is pleased to announce a poster contest for students in grades 6th-8th to help shatter the myths about teen drug and alcohol use. One entry will be chosen from each school for a silver prize, and one gold prize will be picked from the silver winners. This year's theme is- *Shatter The Myths*.

Eligibility: Herkimer County Students grades 6-8th. Individual and group submissions accepted. Maximum of 3 students per group. All students must have their entry form, and media release signed by a parent or guardian.

Theme: Shatter the Myths. Students are encouraged to incorporate provided resources to add statistics, trends, and information to their design.

Poster Requirements: Posters must be created by the student(s) submitting the work. Utilizing images from provided resources or other sources is allowed when appropriate.

Materials: Students may use a variety of media; digital or traditional. Posters will be featured on our website and other media, use of dark bold lines and colors will show up better than light marks.

Poster Dimensions: 11x14" Digital works must be High Resolution- 300 dpi

Prizes & Judging procedure: Each submission will be judged by prevention professionals. Posters will be judged on originality, craftsmanship, and representation of theme. Bronze Awards will be given to all participants. Silver Prizes will be awarded to one winning entry from each participating school. One overall winner will be chosen for the Gold Prize, and will be named the winner for the 2018 Herkimer County Drugs Facts Week Poster Contest.

Important Dates-

January 26: Students submit posters with their entry forms **and** media release to their designated school representative.

February 26th- Winners announced on our facebook page, and contacted through their designated school representative. A press release will be sent to local news outlets.

Gold

Prize includes movie tickets and silver prize.

Silver

Art materials given to the number one entry from each school.

Bronze

Recognition award for each participant.
